### We Can't Drop the Puck Without You!

Behind every great hockey season is a team of dedicated volunteers who make it all possible. You don't need experience – just a willingness to pitch in. Many hands make light work – and without volunteers, our kids simply can't play the game they love. Join us in making this season unforgettable!

There are a few key roles that will need to be filled early on in the season – below is an outline of key roles and their responsibility. # **★ Key Volunteer Roles**

# 🏆 Manager – The Off-Ice MVP

While coaches focus on the action on the ice, the **Manager** handles everything off it — coordinating games, managing tournaments, organizing team communication, and ensuring the season runs smoothly.

You don't need to know everything — just be organized, willing to help, and ready to lean on experienced volunteers and LMHA support. With a strong Manager, the team runs like a well-oiled Zamboni!

Working closely with the Manager, the **Treasurer** is responsible for the dollars and cents — managing the team budget, tracking income and expenses, and making sure families stay informed.

You don't need a finance degree — just a willingness to help, be organized, and follow a few basic guidelines. We'll provide templates and walk you through the steps so you're never on your own.

# 🗣 Parent Liaison – The Calm in the Chaos

Every team needs someone who can stay cool when emotions run high. The **Parent Liaison** acts as the first point of contact when concerns arise and can't be resolved directly.

This role is all about listening, communicating respectfully, and ensuring every family feels heard. Experience with conflict resolution is helpful but not required — you'll be supported by your Division Director and our Game & Conduct Director if needed.

# ✓ Tournament Chair (U7–U13) – The Playmaker of the Home Tournament

The **Tournament Chair** is the lead planner for your team's home tournament. From player packs and team registration to game schedules and fundraising, you'll work with a group of volunteers to make it all happen.

This role takes strong organization, but you won't be starting from scratch. LMHA has templates, timelines, and full support from the Tournament Coordinator to guide you along the way. If you love planning events and making things fun for players and families, this one's for you!
